Dear Mike:

I am pleased to inform you that today I approved the Excessive Shares Amendment (Amendment 20) to the Atlantic Surfclam and Ocean Quahog Fishery Management Plan (FMP) on behalf of the Secretary of Commerce. As you know, Amendment 20 establishes caps on the amount of quota share or annual cage tags an individual or entity can hold in this Individual Transferable Quota program, requires the Council to review those caps at least once every ten years, sets the maximum duration of multi-year specifications to be consistent with the Northeast Region Coordinating Council-approved stock assessment schedule, and updates the goals and objectives of the FMP

We will notify you when the final rule to implement Amendment 20 is scheduled to publish in the *Federal Register*. We appreciate the Council's ongoing efforts to responsibly manage the surfclam and ocean quahog fisheries.
