
Process/timeline

- Introduced at NTAP Panel Meeting Mar 17 2022
- First Subcommittee meeting Apr 8 2022
- Update at NTAP Full Panel Meeting July 13, 2022
- Second Subcommittee meeting Oct 6 2022
 - Reduced scope to NTAP Operations and a simpler NTAP Orientation
 - Moved more detailed information to an Appendix to be developed in the future
- Draft released on Nov 10, 2022









Key organizing principles


- Rely on the NTAP charter
- Rely on materials from NEFMC and MAFMC when pertinent (e.g., operations handbooks)
- Make it clear what it means to be a member of NTAP, expectations
- Provide guidance useful for co-chairs and staff so any turnover can be handled smoothly
- Provide links to relevant materials (not just a list of references)
- Cover background information that includes important context for new and existing members



Writing the manual

We didn't always know the specific procedures. For example, how people become members. In any of such cases, we referenced available materials and the experience of longer-term members to draft the process.

Code of Conduct & Removing Members sections relied on Council documents.

- Editorial comments (typos, word order, organization)
- Factual corrections
- Additions of procedures we should cover that aren't in there now
- Corrections/modifications to procedures described
- Names of additional reviewers we should include for Draft 2

Timeline Comments due Dec 15

Discuss at NTAP meeting in Jan/Feb 2023.

Draft 2 review period estimated Feb/Mar 2023.

To include NEFMC and MAFMC Exec Directors and others recommended by NTAP and the Document Subcommittee

Finalize March/April 2023.
