#### Current 2021 + planned 2022 Specs


- Acceptable Biological Catch (ABC)
  - 17,498 metric tons (mt); 38.6 million pounds
  - 13,408 mt quota; 29.6 million pounds (discards)


- $\blacksquare$  P\* for 2021 = 0.333
  - Extended ABC to 2022 (May 1, 2022)
  - Research Track Assessment underway

Open access, federal trip limit = 6,000 pounds








## **Landings Since Management**






#### Dogfish Landings 2020 and 2021 FYs

## **Dogfish – Advisory Panel FPR**

- Similar sentiments as previous years
- Markets and trip limit restrict landings
- Continued erosion of participants
  - Increased fuel costs and opportunities in other fisheries: 10,000 lb trip limit would increase landings
- 2020 VA landings particularly off
  - Other opportunities, weather
- MA off to a slow start for 2021 fishing year (summer-fall) (public)
  - Availability, skate issue, other opportunities

# **Dogfish – Advisory Panel FPR**

- Science Concerns
  - Bigelow operations performance
  - Dogfish distribution and meaning for trawl index
    - Survey area and water column usage
  - Fecundity



#### Spiny Dogfish

- Data gaps will increase uncertainty, especially 2020 Spring Survey
- 2021 Survey available
  - SSB down slightly and no evidence of a strong year class in 2021
- Research Track Assessment to be completed in 2022
  - SSC recommends collaboration with Canada on ageing methods
  - Alternative modeling approach possible
- SSC did not recommend any changes to current quota


- Uses price as indicator of disruption
- No substantial price effects apparent from two most recent changes

4,000 to 5,000 (2014) and 5,000 to 6,000 (2016)




8,215 Trips with Some Federal Permit 2019-2020 Fishing Years













#### Dogfish - MonCom

- Ex-Officio industry members: Double trip limit to 12,000 pounds
  - Incentivize return to the somewhat higher participation levels as seen in recent years

- MonCom concerns more process oriented...
  - as long as adhering to overall ABC/ACL, different trip limits should not negatively affect stock size
  - Size of change dictates specs/FW, NEPA doc
  - Emergency rule seems unlikely...



### **Dogfish – Trip Limit – Staff...**

 Staff recommendation is status quo given uncertainties about assessment and limited public input

- Emergency action seems unlikely
- Specifications usually deals with smaller changes for spiny dogfish (May target)
- Framework could evaluate options and facilitate public awareness (longer)



#### **Assessment Update**

- Had 2 meetings.
- Evaluating resources to look at aging spines to re-examine growth (currently use a 40-yearold growth curve).
- Council and SSC research recommendations highlighted.
- Just getting started...



#### **Committee Motion 1**

■ I move that the Committee recommend to the Councils that they adopt a trip limit increase to 7,500 pounds via the most expedient process possible (Likely via specifications with an expedited NEPA document if possible).



#### **Committee Motion 2**

I move that the Committee recommend to the Councils that they prioritize a framework to consider additional trip limit changes, with work beginning after the completion of the research track assessment.


