Overview

- Recreational tilefish permits were first issued in August of 2020
- To date, 814 vessels have been issued recreational tilefish permits
- 68 of those vessels have held other permits in addition to rec tilefish permits
- 42 eVTRs have been submitted by 25 vessels for rec trips landing tilefish

Outreach

- Outreach efforts focused on 2020 launch
- Higher than expected number of permits
- Trip reports may reflect low activity, low compliance, or a combination of both
- All permits provide an email address, which could allow for targeting reminders

 Online accounts and apply for the permit
- No strong preferences on reporting app
 - Primarily eTrips Mobile or Fish Online app
 - Users tend to stick with whichever app they use first
