The Monitoring Committee (MC) will review management track assessment information and biomass projections for all three species, as well as recent fishery performance and management measure recommendations from the Advisory Panel, the Scientific and Statistical Committee (SSC), and staff. The MC will recommend 2022-2023 commercial and recreational Annual Catch Limits (ACLs), Annual Catch Targets (ACTs), commercial quotas, and recreational harvest limits (RHLs) for summer flounder, scup, and black sea bass. In addition, the MC should review commercial management measures for all three species and recommend changes if needed.
